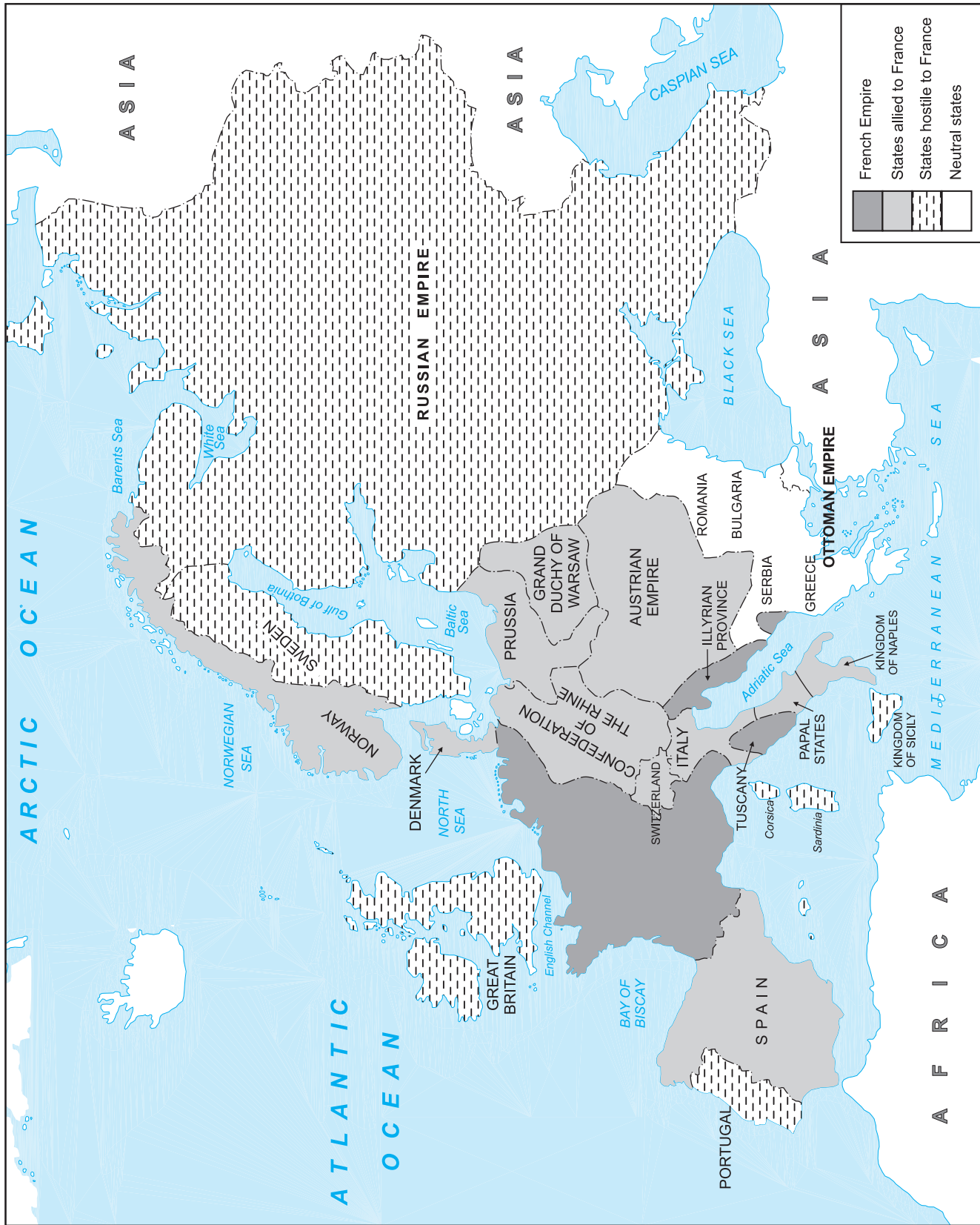

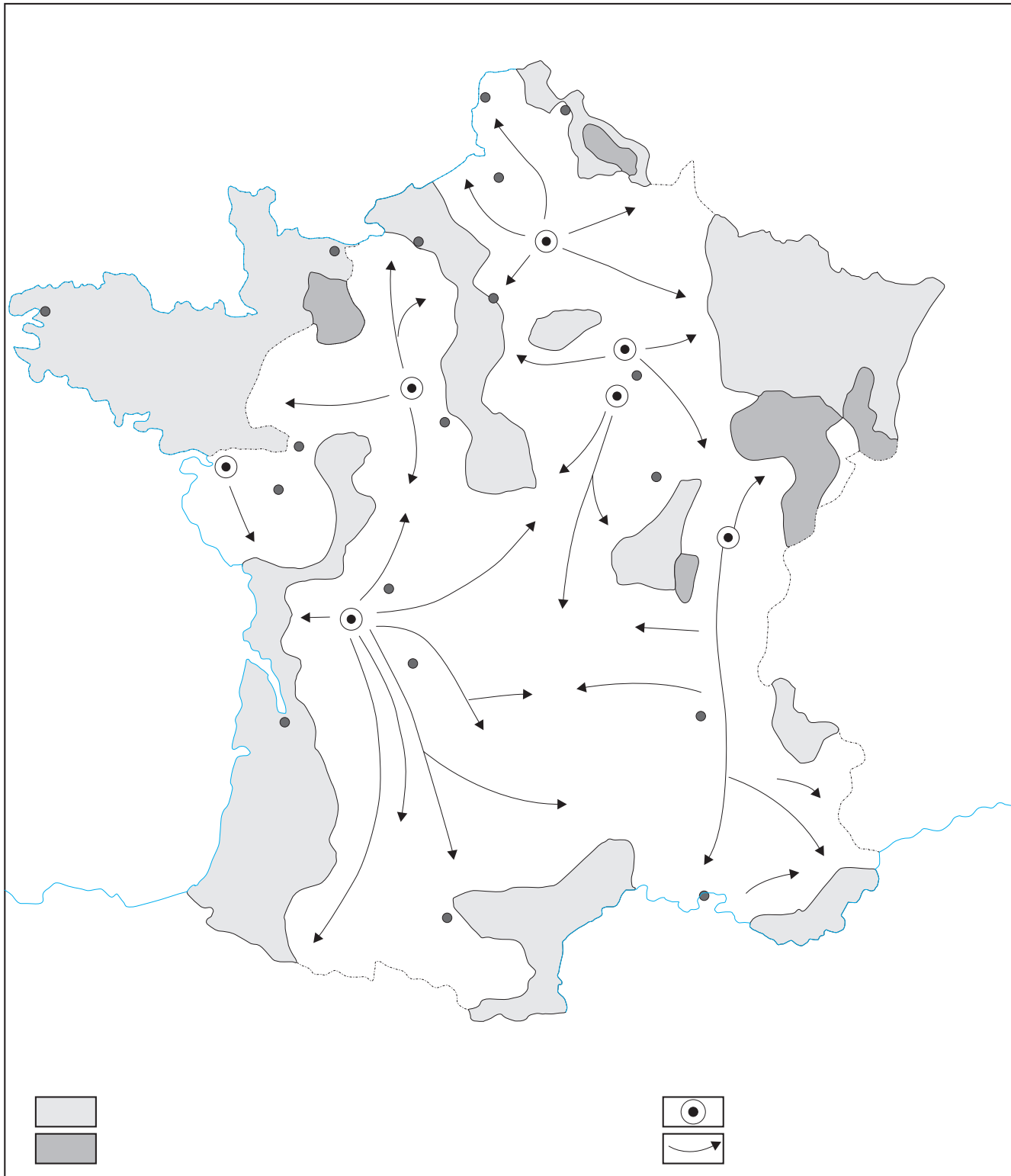


SPREAD OF THE GREAT FEAR IN FRANCE

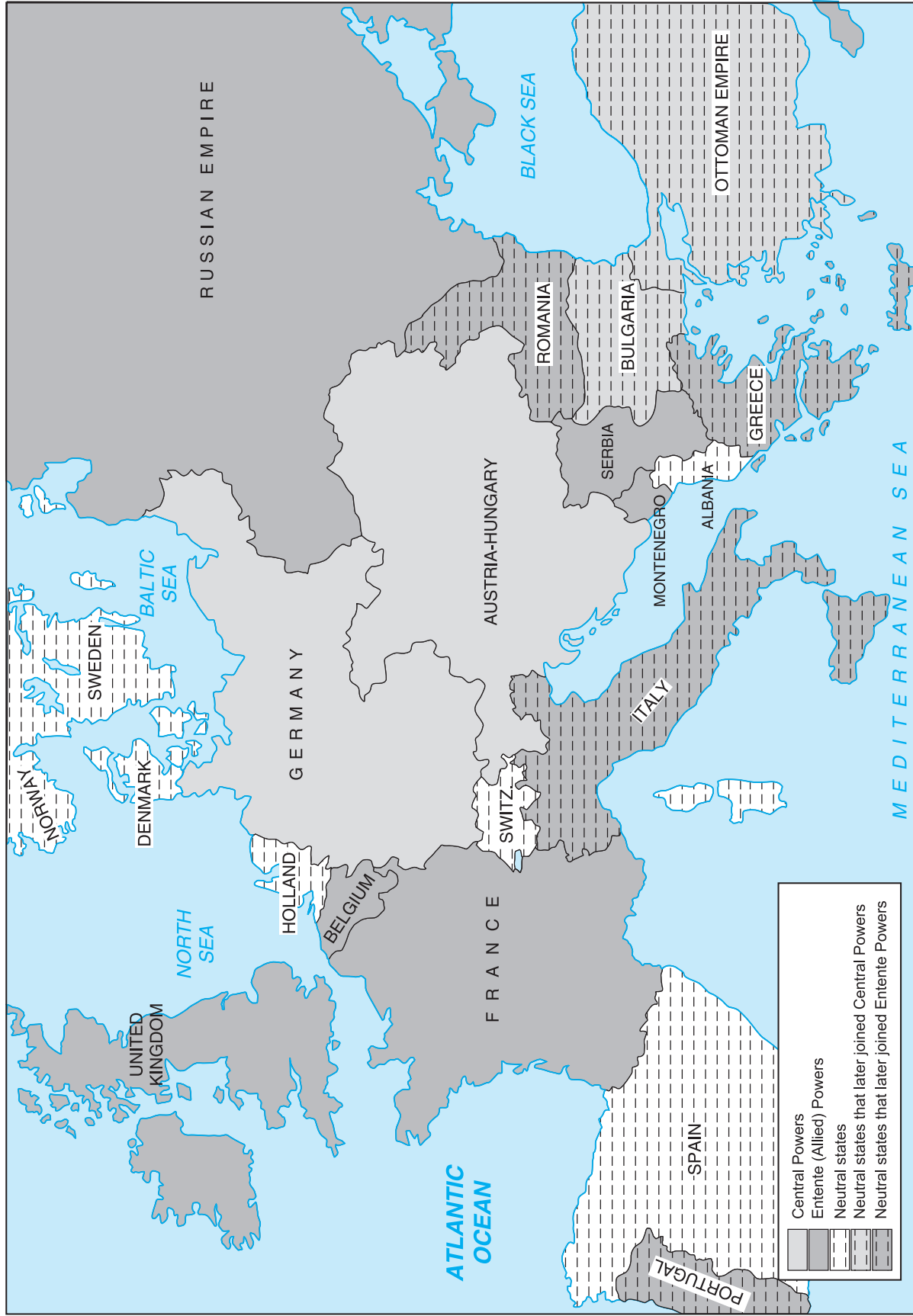

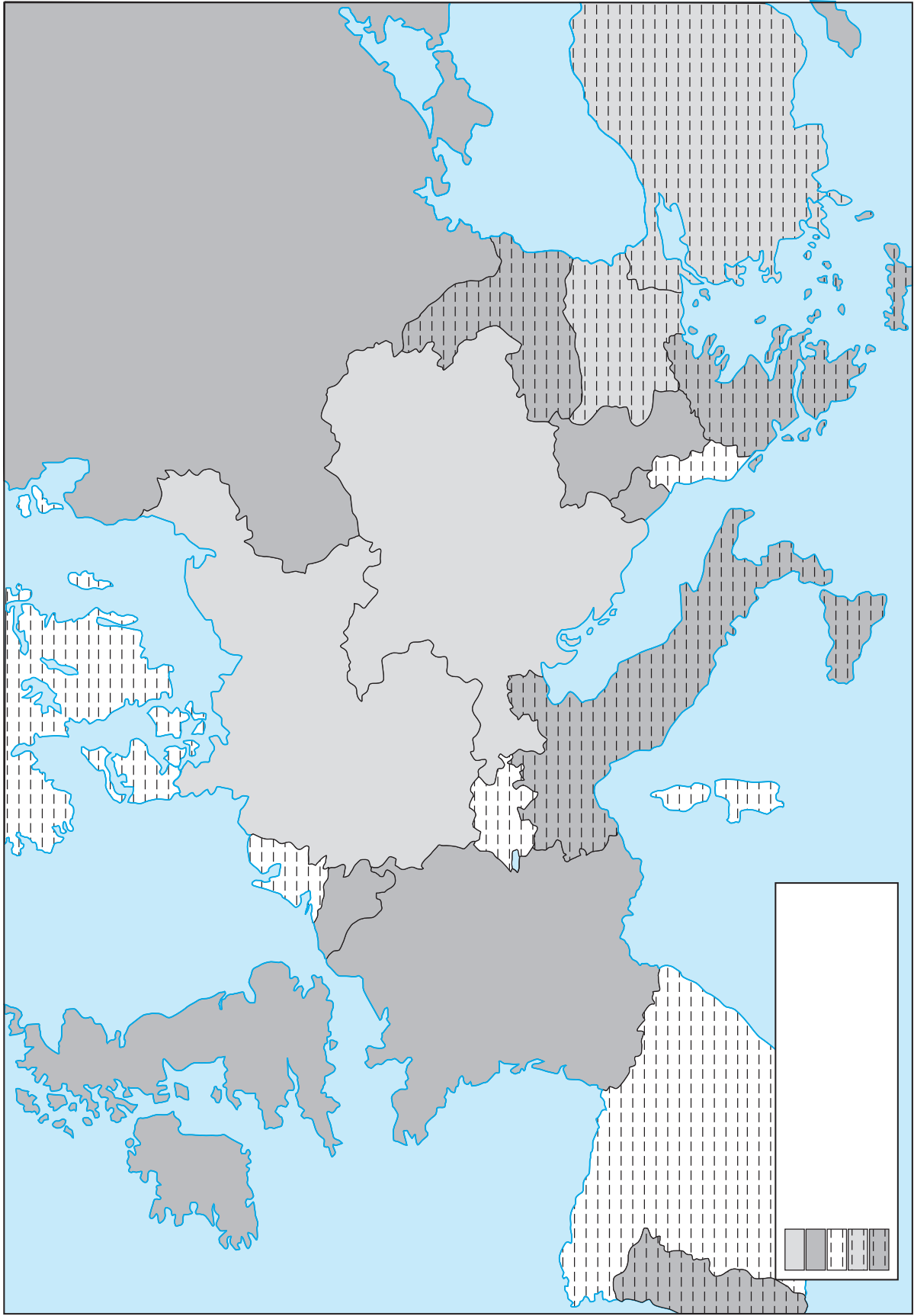


EUROPE IN 1914

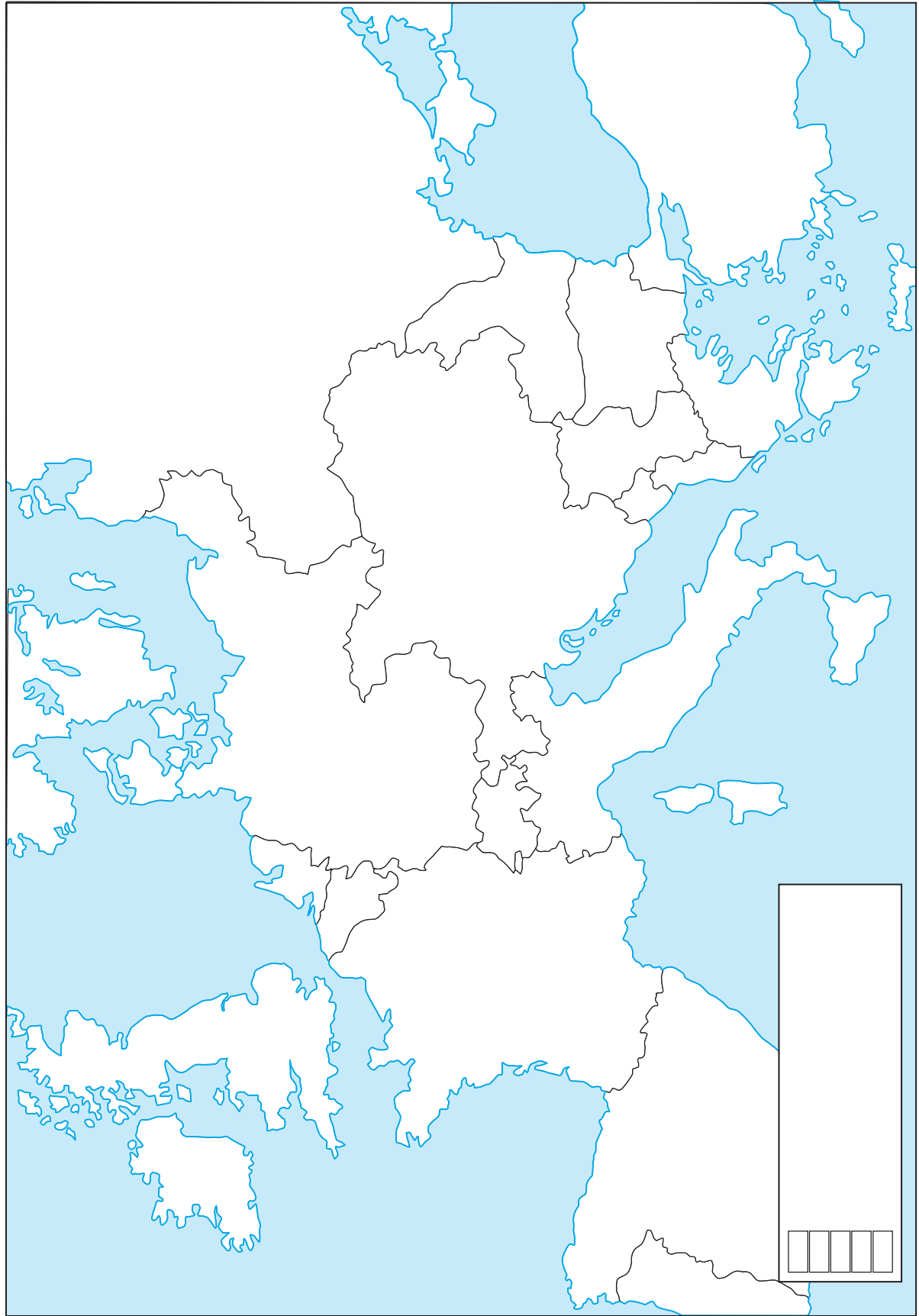
The map shows Europe on the eve of the First World War.



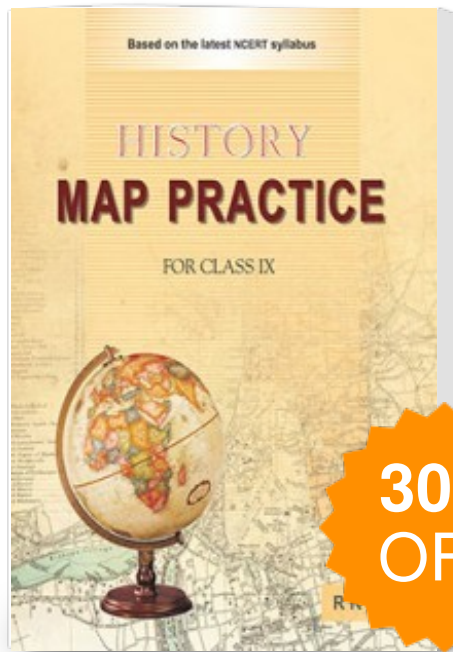
